When the grades of all students are put into the new 'Attainment 8' calculation, taking into account their best 8 subjects including English, Maths, at least 3 English Baccalaureate subjects and 3 other subjects, the students' average score (ie the school's overall Attainment 8 score) was 58.25. The average score per subject is 5.8 (using the scale A*=8, A=7, B=6, C=5, etc).

When the performance of all of the Year 11 students is compared with similar students nationally,

'Progress 8' score for The County High School, Leftwich is +0.57, which means on average students achieved over half a grade better than expected in every one of their GCSE subjects. This places the Academy in the top 2% of all secondary schools nationally.

When the overall 'Progress 8' score is broken down, the English 'Progress' is +0.40 (ie over a third of a grade above expectation), Maths +0.88 (ie nearly a whole grade above expectation), English Baccalaureate subjects +0.67 (two-thirds of a grade above) and 'Other' subjects +0.37 (over a third of a grade above).

86% of students achieved 5 or more GCSEs at Grade C or above (including GCSEs in English Language and Maths)

87% of Year 11 students achieved 5 or more GCSEs at Grade C or above

89% achieved Grade C or above in both English and Maths

48% achieved the 'English Baccalaureate' (Grade C or above in English Language, Maths, Science, a

Humanities subject and a Modern Language)

92% of Year 11 achieved GCSE A* - C in English, with 34% achieving A* or A grades

90% of Year 11 achieved GCSE A* - C in Maths, with 42% achieving A* or A grades

90% of Year 11 achieved GCSE A* - C in Science, with 36% achieving at least one A* or A grade

7% of Year 11 achieved at least 9 A* or A grades

19% of Year 11 achieved at least 7 A* or A grades

28% of Year 11 achieved at least 5 A* or A grades

68% of Year 11 achieved at least one A* or A grade

24% of Year 11 achieved Grade A or A* in all three 'Core' subjects of English Language, Maths and Science
