## **How do I revise?**

### **Collect your books from your teachers – Collect revision notes**

- 1. Find a good place to study. Find a quiet, well-lit place to work that will be comfortable and free of distraction.**
- 2. Using your notes. Re-write out notes, **highlighting**, writing mind maps or Flashcards.**
- 3. Recall and summarize.**
- 4. Drawings or diagrams to make recall easier.**
- 5. Find someone who knows nothing about the topic and explain to them.**
- 6. Try and use a study guide or old test – your teacher may be able to give you these.**
- 7. Let your family help you – test your knowledge.**

English	<p><b>English Language</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Revise Language Reading lessons in your exercise books – the texts were on London Riots, Prisons, Hillsborough and 9/11.</li> <li>• Use your 'Y8 ST2 Revision Booklet' which is full of guidance.</li> <li>• Use spot-comment-zoom to respond.</li> </ul> <p><b>English Literature</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Revise your poetry lessons and the anthology of poems. Explore key quotes and context.</li> <li>• Revise your Literature Poetry lessons and the 'War Anthology' of poems. Explore key quotes and context.</li> <li>• Use your 'Y8 ST2 Revision Booklet' which is full of guidance.</li> <li>• Use spot-comment-zoom to respond.</li> </ul>		
Maths	<p>Students will sit either the Foundation or Higher exam.</p> <p>Students will be assessed on topics in areas across Number, Algebra, Geometry, Statistics, Probability, Ratio and Proportion. The guided revision will be broken down into one calculator and one non-calculator paper and is published on MathsWatch where you can watch videos and complete questions.</p> <p>A Casio calculator is strongly recommended and can be purchased from the payments office for £7.</p>		
Science	<p><b>Paper 1</b></p> <p><b>B4-</b> Photosynthesis and interdependence (food chains/webs).</p> <p><b>C4-</b> Atoms, elements, compounds, periodic table, formulae and forming equations.</p> <p><b>P4-</b> Electricity and magnetism.</p> <p><b>Paper 2</b></p> <p><b>B5-</b> Microbes, disease and the effects of drugs.</p> <p><b>C5-</b> Reactions of metals and non-metals.</p> <p><b>P5-</b> Light.</p>		
Geography	<p><b>Topics to be assessed on will be: Risk-Flooding, Tectonics, Ecosystems.</b></p>		
History	<p>Revise all topics since the start of Y8: The Reformation, Tudor Monarchs, Mary I, Elizabeth I, English Civil War – causes, battles and consequences, The Atlantic Slave Trade.</p>		

<b>French and Spanish</b>	<b>French</b> - Paris / free time activities (3 tenses) / clothes / how you use technology. <b>Spanish</b> - holidays / free time / food and drink preferences / how you use technology.		
<b>Design and Technology</b>	There are revision sheets to be given out and these are also available on the website. The exam will cover the whole of the year's curriculum and Knowledge and skills learnt over the 2 years for Year 8.		
<b>PE</b>	Students will be provided with the revision notes they need.		
<b>Religious Studies</b>	The Year 8 topic is: Pilgrimage. Revision guidance; Where do Christians, Muslims, Sikh and Hindus go on a pilgrimage? What happens on a Muslim, Hindu or Christian pilgrimage? What is the impact of a pilgrimage for religious people?
