Dear Parent/Carer,

We would like to invite you and your child to our online Year 9 Progress Evening on <u>Thursday 4th</u> <u>July 2024.</u> The evening, which will run from 4.00pm to 7.30pm, will give you the opportunity to meet your child's teachers and to discuss progress in their subjects so far in Year 9.

In addition to appointments for core subjects that your child will study from September (English, Maths, Science, Geography, History, French, Spanish) we would only expect appointments to be made in other subjects that your child has chosen as their Options subjects. You may still make appointments in other subjects if you wish.

At the online Progress Evening, Subject teachers will outline what progress has been made at ST2, how well your child is working and what the areas are that they need to focus upon to be successful moving forward in Key Stage 4.

All that is needed is parental details of the 'Priority 1' contact as held on our main school system, an email address and your child's preferred forename & surname and their date of birth.

Appointments can be made from **10.00am** on **Saturday 22nd June 2024.** You will receive an email confirming your appointment(s). It is possible for you to add a second parent/carer so that you can join from different locations and devices.
