In-Person Year 11 Progress Evening – Thursday 13th March 2025 (4:00pm – 7:00pm)

Dear Parent/Carer,

We would like to invite you and your child to our **in-person** Year 11 Progress Evening on **Thursday 13**th **March 2025.** The evening, which will run from 4.00pm to 7.00pm, will give you the opportunity to meet your child's teachers **at school** and to discuss progress in their subjects at a very important stage in this final year.

We feel that through meeting in-person, subject teachers can outline what progress has been made at ST1 and ST2, explain how well your child is working and identify the areas that need to be focused upon to be successful in the summer. Teachers will outline the curriculum and revision focuses for the rest of the year and provide revision resources so that students can prepare effectively in school and can be supported at home. Additional intervention is available in all subjects and teachers may encourage your child to attend sessions in the run-in to the exams.

There will be a **Mock Results Day** on Friday 7th March 2025 when predicted grades will be shared with students, based upon performance in ST2. Tier of entry will be discussed with students in Maths, Science and MFL. **Full reports** will be issued week commencing Monday 10th March. We intend for this process to keep you fully informed about your child's progress and enable you to support them effectively during this time.
